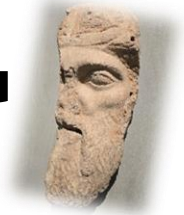

Pawel Kortoniuk gave a report to the Executive Bureau on the accounts for 2023. This report will be presented at the Executive Committee in Zagreb.

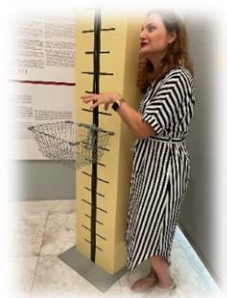
#### 8- Meeting with Mr. Nikolaos Vasilopoulos, HR Director of the Bank of Greece
